EXECUTIVE ORDER \

Upon recommendations of the Honorable, the Secretary of the Interior and the provincial board of Ilocos Sur, and pursuant to the provisions of Act Numbered Seventeen hundred and forty-eight, entitled "An Act authorizing the adjustment of provincial and municipal boundaries and authorizing the change of capitals of provinces and subprovinces, as may be necessary from time to time to serve the public convenience and interest," I hereby transfer all the barrios comprising the former municipality of Salcedo, now a part of the municipality of Santa Lucia, Ilocos Sur, and the barrio of San Gaspar, of the municipality of Candon, from said municipalities to the township of Bauguen, said province.

The municipality of Santa Lucia shall consist of its present territory less the territory comprised in the former municipality of Salcedo.

The municipality of Candon shall consist of its present territory less the territory comprised in the barrio of San Gaspar.

The township of Bauguen shall consist of its present territory plus the territory comprised in the former municipality of Salcedo and in the barrio of San Gaspar. The seat of township government of Bauguen shall be in the barrio of Salcedo.

This order is effective as of July first, nineteen hundred and thirteen.
